WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 24: HEARD MUSEUM / ARIZONA CAPITOL MUSEUM

The internationally acclaimed Heard Museum is one of the best places to experience the myriad cultures and art of Native Americans of the Southwest. Described as the "nation's most prestigious private Indian arts center" by USA Today, the museum was founded in 1929 and held the private collection of Dwight and Maie Bartlett Heard. It now features more than 35,000 artifacts. Be sure to stop by the Museum Shop and Bookstore before boarding the bus. Next stop is the Arizona Capitol Museum, home to the USS Arizona Exhibit. The exhibit brings a personal account of life onboard the USS Arizona in the 1920's and 1930's. The survivors of the attack of December 7, 1941, recount the ship's mighty moments. A large piece of the battleship is on display as well as the United States flag that flew on the ship that day. Both museums are walking tours but can be self-paced.
