## Friday, September 27, 2024:

## PATRIOTS POINT / SHEM CREEK CRAB HOUSE RESTAURANT

Start the morning with a tour of Patriots Point, home of the largest naval and maritime museum in the world. Visit the carrier USS Yorktown, the submarine Clamagore, the Sumner-class destroyer USS Laffey, and a replica of a Vietnam Support base. Priceless war planes used in conflicts spanning from WWII to Desert Storm are featured aboard the Yorktown's 40,000 square foot hangar bay and atop the 888-foot flight deck. Patriots Point is also the home of the Congressional Medal of Honor Society and their official Medal of Honor Museum with interactive exhibits. Reboard the bus and we'll head for lunch at Shem Creek Crab House. You'll be given a lunch voucher in exchange for your choice of entrée salad, sandwich or entrée with chef's choice of accompaniments and beverage.

\*Accessibility – Many exhibits and attractions are accessible; however, portions of the USS Yorktown and USS Laffey are not for those who are unable to climb stairs. There is an elevator available abord the USS Yorktown providing access to the Hangar Bay Level, Flight Deck and Quarters. Patriots Point also offers wheelchairs, at no charge, based on availability as well as golf cart rides from the ticketing area down to the ship (and back).

## Saturday, September 28, 2024: BOONE HALL PLANTATION

Arrive at America's most photographed plantation, Boone Hall Plantation. Drive down the famous three-quarter mile avenue of massive, Spanish moss draped live oaks. Step back in time and relive the grandeur of the Old South when you tour the mansion, smokehouse, gardens, original slave quarters, and cotton gin house.

\*Accessibility - There will be an approximately two block walk to the house from where the buses must stop so, please wear comfortable shoes. Electric wheelchairs or motorized scooters work the best. Much of Boone Hall is outdoors where the terrain varies in different areas on the grounds. Using a standard wheelchair can be difficult to get around. Most of the buildings, including the Mansion and Historic Dwellings, will have 2- 6 steps to get inside or move from room to room. For those that need to sit during touring, please let the guide know and they can make arrangements to have a chair available.

#### 9:30am board bus, 12:30pm back at hotel

\$73/Person includes bus, guide, and admission.

Please be at the bus boarding area at least five minutes prior to the scheduled time. All tours require a minimum of thirty-five people. Driver and Guide gratuities are not included in tour prices. If you use a scooter but can climb the steps to board the bus, either you and/or a person traveling with you must be able to put the scooter in the bus's luggage compartment. Due to liability issues, drivers and tour guides cannot assist with scooters.
